Program Overview:

Intensive Portuguese Language Program at Pontifical Catholic University of Rio de Janeiro: with over 40 years of experience and excellence. VISA:

Visas must be obtained BEFORE the student's entrance in Brazil. A tourist visa cannot be transferred into a student visa once inside the country. A student visa is not required for the Intensive Pre-term course if the student does not intend to stay at PUC-Rio during the following regular semester. If the student also wishes to stay for the regular semester, once the student is accepted by PUC-Rio, CCCI will send a LETTER OF ACCEPTANCE allowing them to obtain a visa at a Brazilian Consulate.

CCCI will send information regarding course fees, academic and international programs calendars, for the period in which the students wish to study at PUC-Rio.

Before arriving:

Students must have a full health insurance coverage;

Students should print out addresses in Brazil (accommodation, PUC-Rio and hospital addresses - the ones covered by your insurance policy) and directions to the PUC-Rio campus as well. MAKE A COPY OF YOUR PASSAPORT
